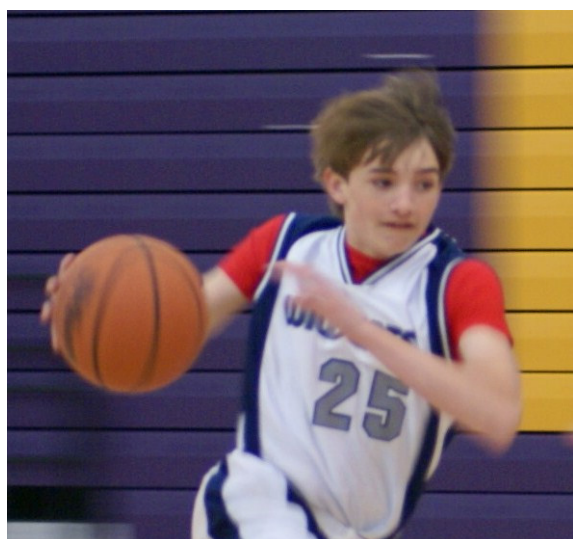

ABOUT US:

The Austin Wildcat Basketball Organization was started in the Spring of 1999 by a handful of parents to give our kids and the children of Austin an alternative to select basketball, but still ensuring that all participants have the skills to play basketball competitively in Middle and High School. Austin Wildcats is a preparatory program with emphasis on player development. The program includes kids from a wide range of public and private schools in the greater Austin and surrounding area.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Q: Are there tryouts for the Fall Academy Programs? **A:** No, this year the Fall Academy Programs will not be divided to Elite, Extreme, Fundamental, and Preparatory Groups, players will practice with their own gender and age groups. Dates and times of tryouts for Select teams will be announced.

Q: When are there games? **A:** The Academy Programs are very similar to a weekly basketball camp with a focus on fundamental and skill development and not games or tournaments. The primary purpose of the Fall Academy is to prepare players for the upcoming school basketball season.

Q: What if my son or daughter is playing school sports? **A:** Our Fall Academy programs hold practices on Sunday afternoons to allow participation of kids who are playing other Fall sports.

Q: Who are the coaches that will be working with my child? **A:** The Wildcat program has a coaching staff made up of Volunteers, Student Interns from the University of Texas and Texas State, and Professional Coaches. Prior Professional Coaches for the Spring/Summer 2010 Season included; Kris Clack, Edwina Brown, and Chico Vasquez.

Q: Can we pay for the Academy program monthly? **A:** Our Academy programs are not month to month. However, you may select the recurring billing option when you register. This option will allow you to pay for a program in monthly installments. If you select this option you are agreeing to pay for the complete program regardless of the level of participation due to camps, vacations, or even loss of interest. Recurring billing is only offered during first month of registration and not available to late registrants.
